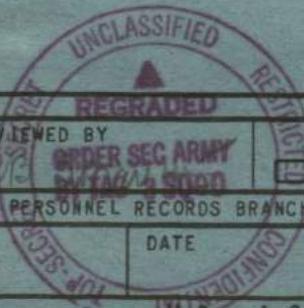

1. The attached photostatic copies of vouchers pertaining to the military pay account of Eddie D. Slovik, 36 896 415 for the period 24 January 1944 through 28 February 1945, are forwarded for your information in connection with the request of Mr. William Bradford Huie.

2. The vouchers indicate that the former enlisted man was recalled to active duty on 24 January 1944 as a private with base pay at the rate of \$50 per month. Deductions were made from his pay in the amount of \$6.70 a month for a class N allotment and at the rate of \$22 a month for a class F allotment. The former enlisted man was last paid in full through 31 July 1944 at Fort George G. Meade, Maryland. He also received a partial payment of \$4.03 in August 1944. The vouchers indicate no further payments since Slovik was absent without official leave from 24 August 1944 through 4 October 1944 and from 8 October 1944 through 9 October 1944. He was held in confinement from 10 October 1944 through date of execution, 31 January 1945.

MEMO FOR RECORD:

The Eddie D. Slovik file was requested by P&H Br, TAGO, to obtain information upon which to base reply to inquiry from PID (Capt. Davis), which was based on a request of Mr. Huie, writer. Because of his third party status, it was not possible to give Mr. Huie much of the information requested, which chiefly was of a personal confidential nature.

Mrs. Jeanette Slovik, now residing in Michigan, visited Washington in connection with Mr. Huie's proposed book and was brought to the P&H Branch, TAGO, by Capt. Davis, PID, 24 Aug 53, to discuss the contents of the file. She, as Emergency Addressee, requested that the entire file be turned over to Mr. Huie but it was explained to her by Col. Wilson, Chief of P&H, that such could not be done. She then asked that the file be turned over to her so that she could do so, but this request was also denied.

Attention is directed to the apparent conflict in interests between the widow, Jeanette Slovik, and the serviceman's Mother, sister and other members of his family. These members have made inquiry indicating they had not been advised of the facts of Eddie Slovik's death and objecting to the release of information to others. The widow admitted that she had not informed the Mother and others about the info she had received from the Army relative to her husband's death, but now wants to reveal the whole story. She had first stated that no information had been given her other than the initial message that her husband had died in ETO on a certain date but later admitted that subsequent information in the form of a confirming letter and a letter from the priest who was present at the execution had been received.

After Mrs. Slovik was advised of just what information was available to her from the file, it was suggested that she make her request in writing, which she agreed to do. Casualty Br (Col. Woodman) was so informed and at their request the file was held in P&H pending receipt of this letter.

In the meantime, several inquiries from Pauline, the serviceman's sister, were received and answered in P&H Branch.

On 14 Sep, a check was made with Casualty Br (LCol Mendell) to ascertain if the expected inquiry from Jeanette Slovik had been received. A negative answer was given and it was decided to keep the file a few more days before returning to MPRC. On 15 Sep P&H was advised that an inquiry from Jeanette had been received in Casualty Branch and that it had just been forwarded on to MPRC in error. It was then decided to return the file to MPRC by airmail so that the communication could be answered there.

Entitled "The Execution of Private Slovik"

1. Publication of the book entitled "The Execution of Private Slovik,"
by William Bradford Huie, has resulted in the raising of certain questions.

2. a. Primary interest in this matter rests with the Office of the
Judge Advocate General and the Chief of Public Information, Department
of the Army, Washington, D. C., which has been consulted.

b. Detailed information is available by calling Major Vernon
Nixon, Magazine and Book Branch, Public Information Division, Ext. 73767.

3. Here are the facts:

a. It is a basic premise of the Department of the Army policy
that the Army is a public instrumentality and that the public is entitled
to a complete accounting of Army activities. When Mr. Huie requested
certain data regarding the Slovik case for presentation to the public,
Department of the Army considerations were two-fold: Does release of
this information compromise security? and Is release of this information
an unwarranted invasion of Slovik's right to privacy? In the case of
the first question, it was determined that security was not a consideration.
Regarding the second point, Mr. Huie obtained from Slovik's next-of-kin,
his wife, a release granting her agreement to make the data available to
the writer. Consequently, there was no valid reason to withhold the desired
information and it was turned over to the author.

b. The basic statements of fact in the book as they pertain
to official actions of the Army are accurate. The unofficial private
discussions, the interpretations, and the interpolations are solely the
author's responsibility. A second basic premise of Department of the Army
policy is that the Army does not have, nor does it desire, the right of
press censorship of the press. Accordingly, the conclusions which
an author or a member of the press draws from a given set of circumstances
are his alone to determine.



1. This office has computed the pay account of Private Slovik from the date he was last paid in full, 31 July 1944, through the date of his execution, 31 January 1945. It has been determined that there is due the United States the amount of \$45.53 as a result of insufficient deductions for allotments. A copy of the computation, with explanatory notes, is attached for your information. Since the debits against Slovik's pay account exceed the credits, no amount is due his widow and no payment has been made to her.

2. With reference to the payment of six months' death gratuity, the Act of 17 December 1919 (41 Stat. 367), as amended (10 U.S.C., Supp IV, 903) provides that there shall be paid an amount equal to 6 months' pay at the rate received by the member at the date of his death immediately upon official notification of the death from wounds or disease of such member when the death is not the result of his own misconduct. Since Private Slovik was executed as the result of the approved sentence of General Court-Martial Orders No. 27, dated 23 January 1945, by reason of conviction of the charge of desertion, his death is considered to be the result of his own misconduct. Therefore, payment of the six months' death gratuity may not be made in this case.

3. The photostatic copies of payrolls pertaining to Private Slovik have been withdrawn and are on file in this office. There is attached a copy of Army Fact Sheet No. 85, which was prepared by the Office, Chief of Information.


