
Gentlemen:

I am responding to your letter dated 9/16/89,
concerning your request for the Henry Classification for Elvis
Presley and Jimi Hendrix.

A search of the criminal and civil name indices for
Elvis Presley and Jimi Hendrix failed to locate a fingerprint
card for either of these persons. Although both persons served
in the U.S. Army, the absence of their fingerprint cards is
possibly due to the fact that approximately 20 percent of the
military fingerprint cards received are returned due to poor
legibility. The U.S. Army may have their fingerprint cards in
their records or could provide you with additional information.

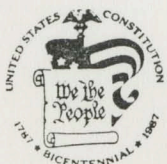

It was suggested by the FBI that the U.S. Army may have the aforementioned information.

The reason for requesting said information is due to the following numerical coincidences relevant to the lives and deaths of Jimi Hendrix and Elvis Presley: Elvis was born seven years before Jimi and he died seven years after Jimi in 1947. Jimi was born in 1942, Elvis was 42 when he died. Elvis died 816, and Jimi died 918. This is the same number backward and upside down

Elvis was born in the year of 1935 (1 | 9 | 3 5)

Jimi Hendrix died in the year of 1970. If we were to add the number of days which exist between 918 and 11/27 (November 27th being the day in which Jimi was born) there is a total of 70 days. (918) September = 12 days

October = 31 days

(11/27) November = 27 days

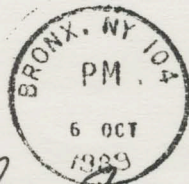




We have reviewed the military personnel files of both individuals; however, the fingerprint classifications are not on file.
