I noticed that Pvt Hendrix had been missing for about twenty minutes so I asked Sp/4 Mattox to see if he could find him. Shortly thereafter I went to the latrine to empty some water and saw Sp/4 Mattox in the latrine. He called me over to show me what was going on, there was Pvt Hendrix masturbating himself. *RSS*

Pvt Hendrix has been assigned to the Repair Parts Supply Section, HQ & Co "A", 801st Maint Bn for approximately 7 months. When Pvt Hendrix was assigned to the section I was at that time warehouse chief of the section and squad leader of the 2nd squad for the platoon. Pvt Hendrix was assigned to my squad. Pvt Hendrix was counseled by myself as to what was expected of him from the company, platoon and section. Pvt Hendrix started out showing lack of interest in his equipment and his work in the section. Pvt Hendrix was again counseled by myself, platoon sergeant and platoon leader over his lack of interest in his equipment and work, but still Pvt Hendrix showed no interest. Constant supervision is necessary to keep Pvt Hendrix from making minor mistakes about which he has been told time after time. On many occasions Pvt Hendrix has been found sleeping on the job. Pvt Hendrix on many occasions has missed bed check.

On 27 April 62 Pvt Hendrix was put on detail to help wash the squad bay for the platoon. Pvt Hendrix was found by Sp/4 Mattox and Pfc Stroble of the detail in the latrine masturbating. This was brought to the attention of myself and S/Sgt Spears. This was reported to the 1st Sgt and Company Commander. Pvt Hendrix still owes a large sum of money for a laundry bill.

In my opinion Pvt Hendrix should be eliminated from the service. **BRB**


