I am requesting, under the U.S. Freedom of Information/ Privacy Act, a very limited review of former-President Richard Milhous Nixon's naval record in the hope that it may provide the answer to a single question.

The question is: where was then-Lieutenant Richard Nixon in late October and early November 1944?

The reason for the question is as follows: there has been a persistent story that Nixon voted by absentee ballot from the South Pacific in the 1944 Presidential election between Roosevelt and Dewey; on the other hand, Nixon's naval record, made available on the Internet by the Staff of the Naval Historical Center, Washington, D.C. states that "From August through December 1944, Nixon was assigned to Fleet Air Wing #8 in Alameda, CA".

Could Nixon have been detached to the South Pacific on some temporary posting about the end of October or early November 1944? Does your office have any information on where Nixon

voted in 1944? Is the absentee ballot story a myth?


I will be grateful if you can provide answers to this apparent conundrum.

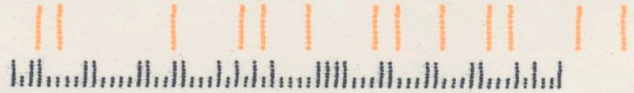
