1. By direction of the President, Major General William Joseph Donovan, (Col-Cav), O-102383, United States Army is relieved from assignment and duty with Office, Chief of Council, Office Assistant Secretary of War, Washington, D.C. effective 12 January 1946; will proceed to his home, New York, New York so as to arrive thereat on 12 January 1946.

2. Terminal leave for 91 days is hereby granted Major General Donovan, effective 13 January 1946. He is relieved from further active duty and will revert to an inactive status 13 April 1946, not by reason of physical disability. Major General Donovan is assigned to Separation Center Fort Dix, New Jersey for record purposes only no travel involved connection thereto, during the period of travel to his home and while on terminal leave. Permanent change of station. Travel by privately owned automobile is authorized. The travel directed is necessary in the military services. 601-32 P 431-02, 03, 07, 08 & 212/60425. Effective date of change on morning report 16 January 1946.

3. The AUS appointment of Major General Donovan will continue in force during the period of the present emergency and for six months thereafter unless sooner terminated by direction of the President.
