Direct commissioning of Sgt. Joe Louis Barrow.

SUMMARY:

- 1. Congressman Adam Clayton Powell wrote the President on 6 March suggesting the direct appointment of Sergeant Joe Louis Barrow to commissioned grade. The Secretary to the President referred the letter on 9 March to the Secretary of War for attention and acknowledgment.
- 2. The attached reply, for the Secretary of War's signature, advises the Congressman that instructions were issued in October, 1943, which discontinued all direct appointments in the Army except to very rare categories, and that the giving of a direct commission to this soldier would, therefore, be in direct contravention to these instructions, and would serve only to shake the confidence of our soldiers in the integrity of our procedures.

INSTRUCTIONS

PURPOSE.—Summary Sheet is used to summarize for quick reading in Office, Chief of Staff, papers prepared by War Department General Staff or by major commands for signature or other action in Office, Chief of Staff or Office, Secretary of War. Papers prepared for signature or other action in Office, Secretary of War, but not channeled through Office, Chief of Staff, do not require Summary Sheet. In general, use of Summary Sheet is limited to following:

- 1. In place of short memorandum for Chief of Staff recommending action or transmitting letter or other paper to be signed or otherwise acted upon in Office, Chief of Staff or Office, Secretary of War. Tissue copy of sheet is prepared for Office, Chief of Staff, as well as comeback and stayback if necessary.
- 2. As brief of long memorandum for Chief of Staff (three pages or more). Tissue copy of sheet is not necessary.

ROUTING.—Routing information and action requested are indicated by "x," check ($\sqrt{}$), or number in appropriate box. As Summary Sheet clears each office, abbreviation of that office in routing box is lined out and papers are forwarded to next office indicated on sheet.

IDENTIFICATION.—Office symbol or abbreviation of office of preparation, grade, surname, and telephone number of dictator, file reference, subject, and date are placed in boxes indicated. File number and subject should be as brief as possible consistent with clarity.

COMPOSITION.—Information presented on Summary Sheet should be sufficiently condensed to be contained on face of sheet, although second page on plain bond may be prepared if necessary. Headings used on Summary Sheet are: SUMMARY and COORDINATION.


Under SUMMARY is stated as concisely as possible essential background information on recommended action or on letter or other paper (if any) transmitted for action.

Under COORDINATION are stated organizations and individuals from whom concurrence or nonconcurrence has been obtained and explanation of unresolved concurrences (if any).

INCLOSURES.—Inclosures are listed according to military practice and begin even with left margin on same line as typed signature.

SIGNATURE.—When papers are prepared in major command, signature on Summary Sheet is that of officer authorized by commanding general to sign; when prepared in War Department General Staff, that of head of division or his authorized representative.

APPROVAL.—Approval of commanding general of major command or of head of division of War Department General Staff, or their authorized representatives, is indicated on Summary Sheet by written initials or name of approving officer above approval stamp or above typed or stamped signature.
