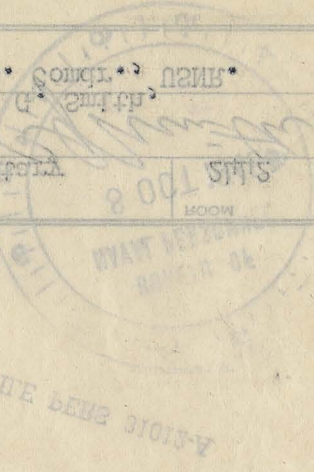
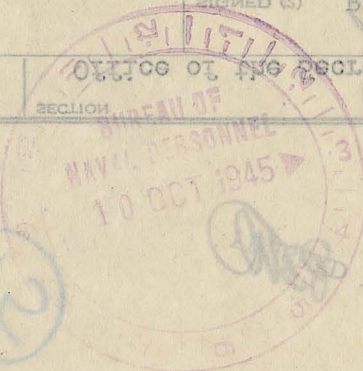

1. Your undelivered orders of 10 September 1945, are hereby cancelled.
2. Your commanding officer is directed to withhold these orders until assured by the disbursing officer carrying your accounts that your final pay, or a substantial portion thereof, will be ready for delivery to you, your next of kin, or your legal representative, as appropriate, on the effective date of your release from active duty.
3. When directed by the Chief of Naval Operations in December 1945, you will consider yourself detached from duty in Naval Operations, Navy Department, and from such other duties as may have been assigned; will immediately report to the Commanding Officer of the Naval Personnel Separation Center (Officer), Washington, D.C., for temporary duty in connection with your separation processing.
4. Upon completion of this temporary duty, and when directed by your commanding officer you will consider yourself detached from all duty; proceed to your home. If hospitalization is required you will be detached from all duty and ordered to report to the National Naval Medical Center, Bethesda, Md., and further compliance with these orders is delayed until you are ready for discharge from treatment. At that time the Medical Officer in Command will perform the duties of the Commanding Officer referred to in these orders. You are hereby granted one month and seventeen days leave to commence the date following detachment from the Naval Personnel Separation Cent (Officer), or upon discharge from treatment, whichever is later and upon expiration thereof, you will regard yourself relieved of all active duty in the Naval Service. All travel will be completed within one year from date of final detachment or discharge from treatment.
5. Immediately upon detachment, you will furnished the disbursing officer carrying your pay accounts a copy of these orders bearing all endorsements, including the date of detachment.
6. Immediately upon detachment you will report your mail address and subsequent changes thereof to the Bureau of Naval Personnel and to the commandant of the naval district in which you reside.
7. The records of the Bureau indicate that your home of record at the time you were ordered to active duty was Ridgefield, Conn., and that you were orders to active duty from that place.

1. Reference (a) requests comment and recommendation regarding H.R. 9758, the purpose of which is stated in its title.

2. It is well-recognized that Captain Steichen's patriotism and service to his country have been outstanding. As one of the World's leading artists and photographers he has served with distinction throughout World Wars I and II and although he was placed on the retired list during the latter war he continued to serve until the war's conclusion. His technical assistance in helping to develop naval photography during World War II and his great contributions to the Navy's photographic historical record of that war has been, and will continue to be, of inestimable value. Since the war he has, at his own expense, continued to assist the Navy by giving technical assistance in many instances, and through travel, writings and exhibits which paid great tribute to the Navy.

3. The Chief of Naval Personnel considers that the honorary promotion of Captain Steichen to rear admiral on the retired list would be a fitting expression of gratitude in appreciation of his outstanding contributions to the Navy. Since Captain Steichen's promotion cannot be accomplished without legislation, the Chief of Naval Personnel recommends that the Department of the Navy offer no objection to the enactment of H.R. 9758.

My dear Senator Kefauver:

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of February 23, 1956 concerning the promotion of Captain Edward Steichen to Rear Admiral.

Some time ago I received a recommendation from Admiral Felix B. Stump, Commander-in-Chief, United States Pacific Fleet, that Captain Steichen be promoted to rear admiral on the retired list in recognition of his outstanding contributions to the Navy in the field of photography and of his patriotism and devotion to duty which led him to volunteer for active service in the Navy during World War II at an age (over 60) when none of the Armed Forces would ask or require his services.

Since Captain Steichen is on the Naval Reserve retired list he cannot be promoted to the grade of rear admiral except by means of private legislation.

After carefully studying this proposal, both the Judge Advocate General of the Navy and I concluded that the Department of the Navy was not in a position to officially sponsor such legislation. I so informed Admiral Stump and suggested that it would be preferable if this matter were handled by means of privately sponsored legislation. I also furnished Admiral Stump with a sample bill which I believed would accomplish the desired purpose.

Should such legislation be introduced I cannot state authoritatively what the position of the Navy Department would be on this proposal. In a rather recent similar case, a private bill was introduced to authorize the promotion to rear admiral on the retired list of Commander Donald B. MacMillan, USNR (retired), the polar explorer. The Navy took the position that that bill was an appropriate expression of gratitude for his services, and no objection was interposed to its enactment. That bill became Private Law 447, 83rd Congress. Personally, I see no reason why the Navy's position would not be the same should similar legislation be introduced in behalf of Captain Steichen. I am in thorough agreement with you that this appears to be a very meritorious case.
