1. Recommend that Recruit E-1 Jerome J. Garcia, RA19666366, a member of this battery, be eliminated from the military service prior to his scheduled termination of enlistment by reason of character and behavior disorders under the provisions of paragraph 3b, AR 635-209, without board hearing per authority contained in paragraph 8, AR 635-209. Recommend General Discharge be furnished.

2. Report as specified in paragraph 6, AR 635-209, is submitted as follows:

a. Name, grade and service number: Garcia, Jerome J., Recruit E-1, RA19666366.

b. Date of enlistment: 12 April 1960.

c. Term of enlistment: Three (3) years.

d. Prior service: None.

e. Individual does not hold a reserve commission or warrant.

f. Reasons for action recommended: Recruit Garcia has incurred three (3) battery punishments under Article 15 of the Code, and one (1) summary court-martial, since his assignment to this command in August 1960. Garcia has steadfastly maintained a defective attitude toward superiors, authority, and military life in general. His personal appearance, personal cleanliness, and personal billeting area in the barracks, although minutely improved upon through constant supervision and instruction, have been and are currently much below the standards prescribed and maintained in this unit. In spite of repeated counseling by his superiors, Garcia has made no effort to soldier, perform, or meet the standards expected of a soldier in any manner.

h. Description of attempts made to develop the individual: Recruit Garcia's defects are character and behavior disorders; defective attitude; substandard soldiering qualities and duty performance; and unwillingness to accept authority, discipline or responsibility. He is an immature individual, whose "I don't care" attitude is not compatible to rehabilitation. He has been counseled, advised and given the opportunity by the undersigned to develop himself as a soldier and as an individual. When I took command of this unit, on 7 November 1960, Garcia was performing routine battery details. I found that he had previously been assigned as a mechanic in the motor pool. I thought perhaps a specific job assignment would help the situation, and that Garcia should be given another chance to soldier. On 10 November 1960, I personally interviewed Garcia to determine, in spite of his previous substandard duty performance and repeated misconduct, whether he could be persuaded to make an effort to cooperate with me in bringing his soldierly qualities up to desired standards. However, Garcia made it very clear to me, on 10 November 1960, that he had no desire to improve himself as a soldier, that a change of duty assignment or even a change in unit assignment would not affect his present defective attitude toward the military, and that he was only interested in getting out of the Army as soon as possible. Based on this interview, I did not assign Garcia to a specific job assignment. His motivation is so poor that it is impractical to assign this man to any assignment of responsibility. In my opinion, Recruit Garcia's elimination from the service UP AR 635-209 is in the very best interests of the United States Army.
