

1. Pfc James J Bulger, AF 11182966, hereinafter referred to as subject, was arrested 16 March 1947 by Boston Mass. Police. He was not convicted of the charge, i.e. Robbery, Unarmed.
2. Subject was arrested on or about 6 Jan 1948. The charge, Assault with intent to rape was officially changed to Assault and Battery. Subject convicted of Simple Assault. His sentence was a fine only.
3. Subject is not believed to have enlisted fraudulently, by virtue of section 32, Enlistment Record, United States. i.e. Subject was not convicted of the Felony, Robbery Unarmed.
4. Section 35, Enlistment Record, United States, states truly the information contained.
5. Believe subject should not be discharged, per per B, AF Reg 39-21, insofar as it states it will be the general policy to retain individuals in the service, who, upon enlistment, concealed a conviction not punishable by death or imprisonment for more than one year.




