for service as set forth in the following

CITATION:

"For heroism and extraordinary achievement in aerial flight as a Fighter Pilot and Section Leader in Fighter Squadron THIRTY TWO, attached to the U.S.S. LEYTE, in action against enemy aggressor forces in the Korean Area from 12 October to 4 December 1950. Participating in twenty strikes during this period, Ensign Brown led his section in daring attacks on enemy military installations, lines of communication, transportation facilities and troop concentrations at Choshin Reservoir, Ta-ku-shan, Manp'ojin, Lin-chiang, Sinuiju, Kasan, Wonsan, Ch'ongjin, Songjin, Kilchu and Sinanju. Flying in support of units of the First Marine Division surrounded by the enemy in the vicinity of the Choshin Reservoir, he pressed home numerous attacks on hostile troops moving to attack our forces, continuing his aggressive runs despite heavy opposition until his plane was fatally struck by enemy antiaircraft fire. His exceptional courage, airmanship and devotion to duty in the face of great danger reflect the highest credit upon Ensign Brown and the United States Naval Service. He gallantly gave his life for his country.

- 1. In accordance with reference (a), it is recommended that WCENSIGN Jesse Leroy BROWN, 504477/1315, U.S. Naval Reserve, attached to and serving with Fighter Squadron THIRTY TWO, be awarded the Air Medal (First Award) posthumously for meritorious achievement while participating in aerial flights.
 - 2. During the period 12 October to 7 November 1950 ENSIGN BROWN participated in ten strike missions over hostile North Korean territory. He led his section and aided his division in attacks against enemy troops, railroad cars, armored vehicles, and high-way bridges in the vicinity of WONSAN, CHONGJIN, and SONGJIN. In the vicinity of SINANJU, he assisted in close support for ground forces resulting in their accelerated advance. Anti-aircraft fire was encountered on nearly all of these missions.
 - 3. The facts set forth in the enclosed citation are personally known to me.
 - 4. None of the flights or strikes considered in the total upon which recommendation is based has been used as the basis for another award.

PROPOSED CITATION IN THE CASE OF ENSIGN JESSE LEROY BROWN, 504477/1315, U.S. NAVAL RESERVE

For distinguishing himself by meritorious achievement in aerial flight as Pilot of a Fighter Plane in Fighter Squadron THIRTY TWO, attached to the U.S.S. LEYTE (CV-32), in attacks on hostile North Korean Forces, while upholding policies of the United Nations Security Council. Participating in ten (10) strikes on enemy military installations, lines of communications, transportation facilities, and enemy troops in the face of grave hazards at WONSAN, CHONGJIN, SONGJIN, KILCHU, and SINANJU during the period 12 October to 7 November 1950, ENSIGN BROWN performed his assigned missions with skill and courage. His devotion to duty was at all times in keeping with the highest traditions of the United States Naval Service.
