To the Army Chemical Center, Edgewood, Md. reporting prior to 1600, 5 June 1949 to the Commanding Officer of the Naval Unit, for temporary additional duty in connection with a three (3) weeks indoctrination course in Chemical Warfare, Radiological Defense and associated subjects. The class convenes 6 June 1949.

3. Travel by Government Air is directed where available except as noted below.

4. For travel by Military Transport Aircraft, Class three (3) priority is certified.

5. Authority is granted to travel via privately owned conveyance at no expense to the government. Travel time will not exceed that allowed via rail. If you do not desire to bear this expense, consider the authorization void.

6. A per diem of \$7.00 in lieu of subsistence will be allowed while absent from your station in accordance with paragraph 4153, U. S. Navy Travel Instructions, except while at Edgewood, Md. where no per diem will be allowed.
