AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL FOR HEROISM

1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced.

RESCORLA, CYRIL R. 05325638 SECOND LIEUTENANT INFANTRY USA
Co B, 2d Bn, 7th Cav, 1st Cav Div, APO US Forces 96490

Awarded: Bronze Star Medal with "V" Device

Date action: 3 October 1965

Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For heroism in connection with military operations against a hostile force: Second Lieutenant Rescorla distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous action on 3 October 1965 while serving as a platoon leader on a search and destroy mission in the vicinity of An Kee, Republic of Vietnam. At approximately 0830 hours, Lieutenant Rescorla was leading his platoon through a dense jungle area, when suddenly a booby trapped grenade exploded, wounding him and a member of the platoon. Immediately after the grenade was detonated the entire element was taken under heavy Viet Cong sniper fire. Even though wounded, he refused medical evacuation. With complete disregard for his own personal safety, Lieutenant Rescorla led a fire team in an assault on the hostile positions. Exposing himself continuously to the intense hostile fire, he was instrumental in defeating the Viet Cong attempted ambush. Not until Lieutenant Rescorla completed his mission did he accept medical treatment. His outstanding performance and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.

AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR

1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced.

RESCORLA, RICHARD C. Q5325637 SECOND LIEUTENANT INFANTRY United States
Army Co B, 2nd Bn, 7th Cav, 1st Cav Div (Air), APO US Forces 96490

Awarded: Silver Star

Date action: 15 November 1965 to 17 November 1965

Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry in action: Second Lieutenant Rescorla distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous actions from 15 November 1965 to 17 November 1965 while serving as platoon leader engaged in defending a landing zone against a Viet Cong battalion in the Ia Drang Valley, Republic of Vietnam. As Second Lieutenant Rescorla's platoon came under intense hostile fire, he demonstrated courage, strategy, and professional competence which insured the successful accomplishment of his platoon's mission. During the ensuing three hour battle, Second Lieutenant Rescorla exposed himself to the heavy volume of Viet Cong automatic weapons fire while moving from foxhole to foxhole to personally direct the retaliatory fire of his platoon and urge them to battle. As a result of this action, the attacking Viet Cong Battalion sustained heavy losses and retreated. During the course of action Second Lieutenant Rescorla directed his squad and fire team in the elimination of pockets of hostile resistance throughout the battlefield. On two occasions. Second Lieutenant Rescorla with complete disregard for his personal safety assaulted well fortified Viet Cong machine gun positions and neutralized them with hand grenades. He was most instrumental in the defense of the landing zone and the defeat of the Viet Cong battalion. Second Lieutenant Rescorla's actions were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.

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



TOTAL SERVICE (QUALIFYING AND NONQUALIFYING) FOR LONGEVITY PAY PURPOSES

21 01 27

1. The following information is furnished to answer many of your questions concerning the statement of military service and the statutes applicable to retired pay.

2. Title 10, United States Code, Chapter 67, Sections 1331-1337 authorizes retired pay benefits to members and former members of the Reserve components who have completed a minimum of 20 years qualifying service and attained the age of 60.

3. Before 1 July 1949 it was not necessary for an individual to actively participate or earn retirement points in order to be credited with qualifying service. You only had to be a member of a Reserve component, AUS without component or active Federal service. Fifty retirement points exclusive of any active duty/active duty for training is automatically credited for a full year prior to 1 July 1949. One (1) point is credited for every day of active duty/active duty for training performed prior to 1 July 1949. Beginning on 1 July 1949 the law has required reservists to earn a minimum of 50 retirement points each full retirement year in order to have that year credited as qualifying service. For periods less than a full retirement year a proportionate number of points for the fraction of a year must be earned in order to have that period credited as qualifying service. The law further provides that no more than a combined total of 60 points may be credited for inactive duty training, extension courses, and membership, e.g. an individual had 48 IDT, 23 extension course points and 15 membership points for a total of 86 points, of this total only 60 points will be awarded for retired pay in accordance with the law. If this individual had active duty it would be added to the 60 point total.

4. Only members assigned to an active status in a Reserve component or in active Federal service are authorized to earn and be credited with retirement points. The law prohibits crediting of retirement points earned after an individual reaches mandatory removal date (MRD); even though the individual remains in an active status beyond the MRD through administrative oversight. The law does provide that retirement points are authorized for those individuals who have been retained in an active status beyond MRD by proper authority under a specific provision of law.

5. Retirement year once established will not change as long as the member has continuous active status in a Regular and/or Reserve component. A new retirement year will be established when there is a break in active status (i.e., discharge, transfer to inactive Reserve or inactive National Guard, or assigned to the Retired Reserve) and the individual returns to an active status. In such cases the new retirement year begins on the date of return to an active status. If served in more than one component during a retirement year, without a break in active status, the component you last served in for that retirement year will be shown.

6. It is the responsibility of each eligible member to make application for retired pay at age 60. The only form that application can be made on is a DD Form 108 which can be obtained at any military installation. The completed DD Form 108 should be forwarded to the Commander, U.S. Army Reserve Components Personnel and Administration Center, ATTN: AGUZ-RAS-SC, 9700 Page Blvd., St. Louis, MO 63132, approximately 90 days prior to reaching 60th birthday.

7. Correction Instructions: Review your statement very carefully. If an incorrect period of service is shown, it will not be necessary for you to reconstruct the entire retirement year to obtain a correction. Furnish only the required documents which substantiate your reasoning for a change in the statement of the retirement year in question.

a. IRR members: Submit request for correction to address as shown in paragraph 6 above. Additional information may be obtained from your Personnel Managers.

b. TPU members: Submit corrective action through unit of assignment.
