AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR

1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced.

RESCORLA, RICHARD C. 05325637 SECOND LIEUTENANT INFANTRY United States Army Co B, 2nd Bn, 7th Cav, 1st Cav Div (Air), APO US Forces 96490

Awarded: Silver Star

Date action: 15 November 1965 to 17 November 1965

Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry in action: Second Lieutenant Rescorla distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous actions from 15 November 1965 to 17 November 1965 while serving as platoon leader engaged in defending a landing zone against a Viet Cong battalion in the Ia Drang Valley, Republic of Vietnam. As Second Lieutenant Rescorla's platoon came under intense hostile fire, he demonstrated courage, strategy, and professional competence which insured the successful accomplishment of his platoon's mission. During the ensuing three hour battle, Second Lieutenant Rescorla exposed himself to the heavy volume of Viet Cong automatic weapons fire while moving from foxhole to foxhole to personally direct the retaliatory fire of his platoon and urge them to battle. As a result of this action, the attacking Viet Cong Battalion sustained heavy losses and retreated. During the course of action Second Lieutenant Rescorla directed his squad and fire team in the elimination of pockets of hostile resistance throughout the battlefield. On two occasions. Second Lieutenant Rescorla with complete disregard for his personal safety assaulted well fortified Viet Cong machine gun positions and neutralized them with hand grenades. He was most instrumental in the defense of the landing zone and the defeat of the Viet Cong battalion. Second Lieutenant Rescorla's actions were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.




