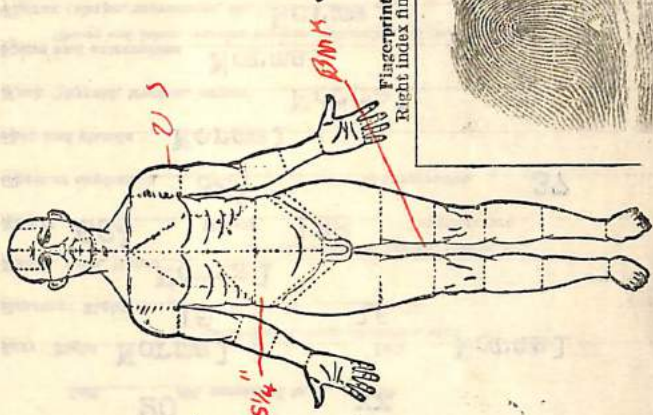
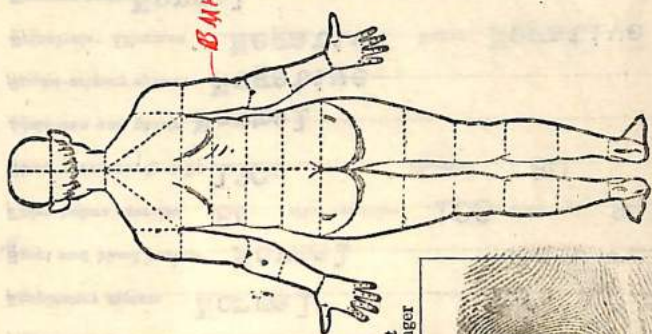

HISTORY: At 8 am on 11-20-43, while in a tank which was engaging the enemy, patient was struck in left thigh by two bullet fragments which pierced the armor of the tank. No wounds of exit. Received first aid dressing in tank Then crawled out into shallow water, and crawled over coral reef to a boat 200 yards away.

Was then taken aboard the ship, where he received tetanus toxoid, plasma, and sulfathiazole by mouth. Also, sulfathiazole powder was applied to wound.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION: There are two oval wounds of the upper anterior left thigh, one about 1½" in diameter. The other 1" in diameter. The larger wound has a larger blood clot filling it. There is extensive ecchymosis of the posterior thigh. No wound of exit present.

12-18-43; NP REPORT: Extension and flexion of muscles of the toes, foot and leg performed well except for weakness of the quadriceps femesis due to local damage. There are no sensory changes. Achilles reflex's active. The patella is diminished but this is probably

P.I. Nov. 20, 1943 pt. was struck by a hollow point exploding bullet in the left thigh. The bullet hit a tin wall, exploded and the pieces of lead struck him in the lt. thigh. There are allegedly many pieces of lead in his left thigh. He lost much blood and became very weak, 1 plasma transfusion was given. On Nov. 27 aboard the Solace 2 pieces of lead were removed from the anterior aspect of the left thigh. The wound remained uninfected. On Dec. 2 he arrived at Aiea Heights N.H. The wounds were dressed daily, no other treatment. On Dec. 3rd pt. arrived at this hospital for further disposition. At present he has good motion in the leg but it is not so good as normal. There is no pain in the leg at rest, however jumping or striking the left leg causes pain in the anterior and lateral aspect of the thigh. The ant. and lat. aspect of the thigh are sensitive to touch. Other than




